



CODE OF CONDUCT

West Virginia SkillsUSA wants every person to have an enjoyable experience with maximum attention paid to safety and comfort. Everyone will be expected to conduct himself/herself in a manner best representing the nation's greatest student organization.

In order that everyone may receive maximum benefits from their participation, the "Code of Conduct" as established by the National SkillsUSA Board of Directors and amended by the West Virginia SkillsUSA Association must be followed at all times.

- Participants' conduct shall be the responsibility of the chapter advisor from participant's school.
- Participants shall be prompt and prepared for all activities.
- Participants shall keep their advisors/directors informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
- Participants shall wear identification badges at all times.
- Participants shall not deface property. The individual or chapter responsible will pay for any damages to property or furnishing in hotel rooms or buildings.
- Participants shall spend the night or nights at assigned hotels, in assigned rooms.
- Participants shall be in their respective rooms and quiet at curfew.
- Participants shall not be permitted in sleeping rooms with members of the opposite sex.
- Participants shall be prohibited from having alcoholic beverages or drugs in any form.
- Participants shall not be permitted to smoke.
- Student participants shall not leave the hotel unless permission from their advisor/director has been obtained.
- Participants shall attend all general sessions and activities for which they are assigned and registered.
- Participants shall adhere to the dress code at all times (official dress or business like attire).
- Participants violating any of these rules of conduct will subject their entire delegation to being unseated, and may cause their candidates or skills championship entrants to be disqualified.
- Participants may be sent home at their own expense for violating any of these rules of conduct.
